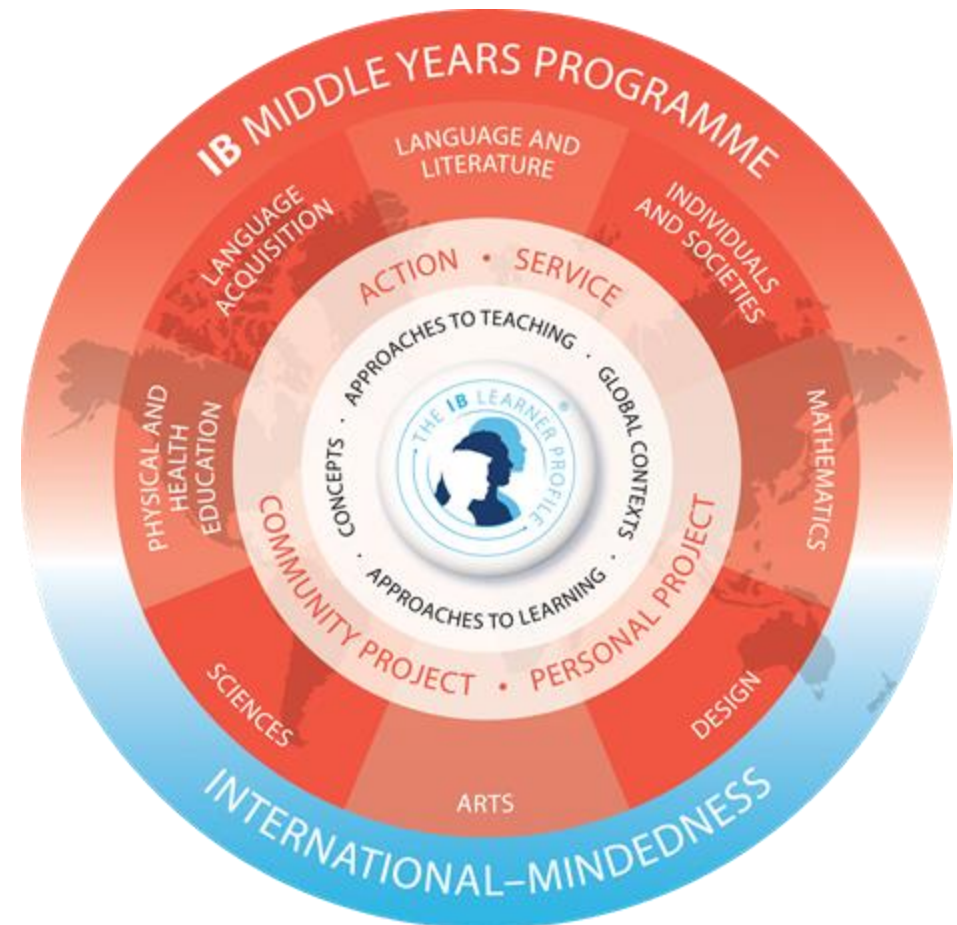

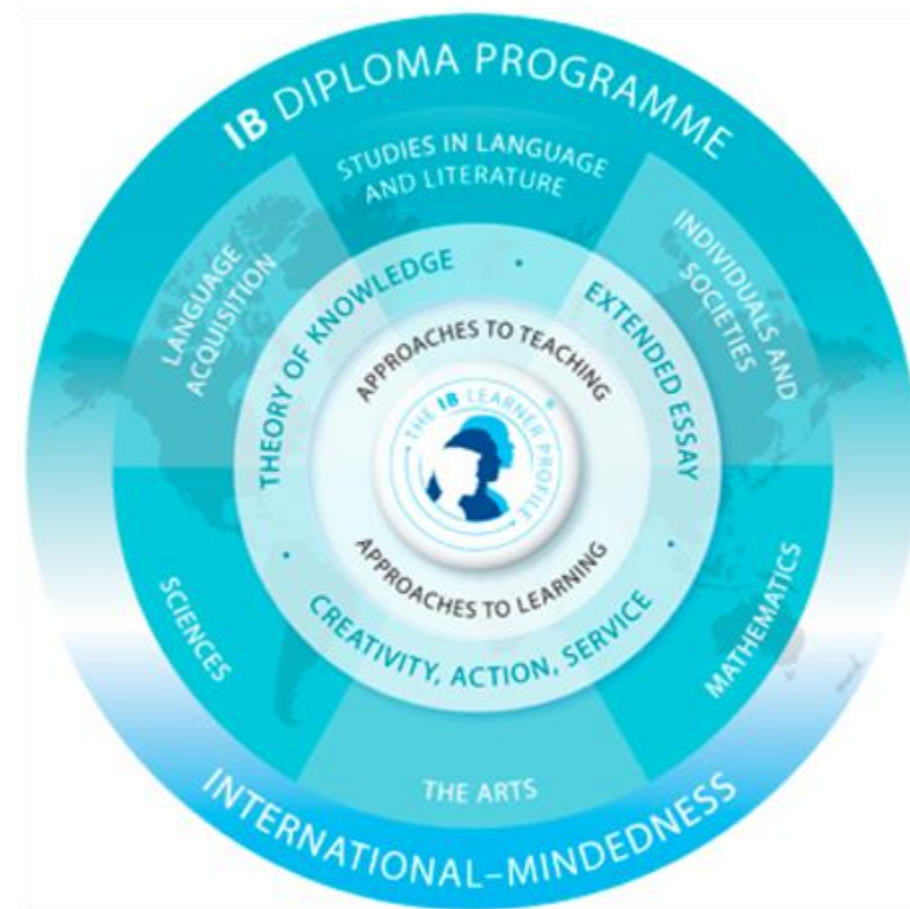

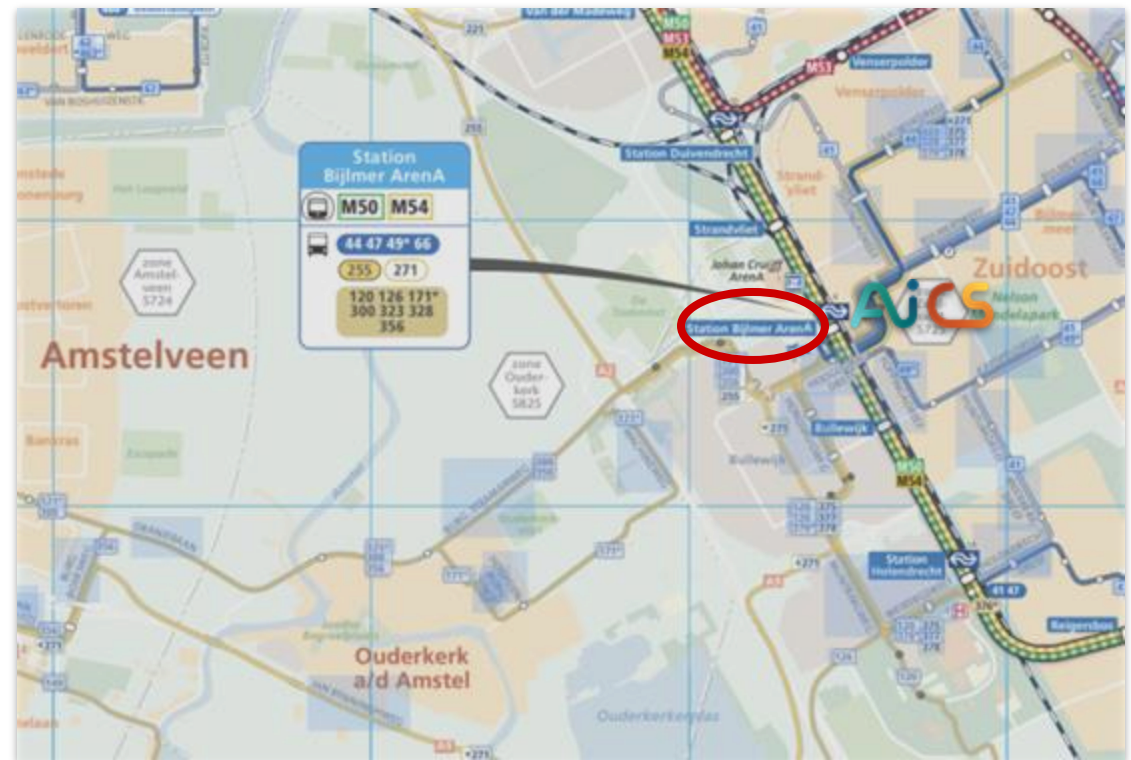
- Open for the start of the 2023-2024 academic year
